What We CAN Accept:

- Kids clothing, boys & girls size infant to teen in **clean**, good wearable condition
- All sizes & gender of shoes in **clean**, good wearable condition
- **New** in package undergarments and socks
- New or like New Winter clothing, jackets, snow pants, boots, hats, and mittens/gloves in **clean**, good wearable condition
- **New** Bedding

What We CAN NOT Accept:

- Used undergarments or socks
- Used bedding
- Used Stuffed Animals
- Used Car seats or booster seats
- Used Cribs, Beds, pack and plays or Mattress
- Used Household Items (dishes, paintings, kitchen appliances, cookware, etc)

AFFM accepts donations by appointment on Thursdays and Fridays between the hours of 9:00 am and 3:30 pm.

Please take the time to wash and thoughtfully sort through your donations. Otherwise volunteers end up taking a significant time sorting and through out unusable items; that is no fun and a bit disheartening to volunteers that spend countless hours sorting. PLEASE NO faded, pilling, torn, moldy, stained or inappropriate clothing. **Thank you for all the lovingly sorted and washed donations you bring to us, we are doing our best to make sure they reach children in care.**
